Best Researcher Award

Introduction

1. Research has always been a very important component of universities all over the world. Faculty members performing extraordinary research are recognized and rewarded for their contribution towards achieving research excellence. NUST, being a research led university, fully recognizes the importance of research as well as recognition of outstanding researchers of NUST.
2. NUST Best Researcher Award policy is in vogue since past few years, however, it is being reviewed to make the criteria more comprehensive and in line with the contemporary trends which are the fuel for betterment of research index.

Types of Best Researcher Awards

3. There are two types of Best Researcher Awards being awarded at NUST:
 - a. **University Best Researcher Award**
This award is conferred at university level to the overall best performing researcher of NUST with a certificate and cash prize of PKR 150,000/-.
 - b. **School / College Best Researcher Award**
This award is conferred at School / College level to the best performing researcher of the respective institution with a certificate and cash prize of PKR 75,000/-.

Eligibility Criteria

4. Eligibility criteria formulated below is for the Best Researcher Award for University as well as School / College. Faculty member being considered for the awards must meet the following criteria:
 - a. The researcher must hold a regular 'faculty / staff position' at NUST.
 - b. Minimum two year service in NUST is essential.
 - c. Once awarded, re-nomination shall be considered after three years.
 - d. Data for the calendar year under consideration will only be applicable.
 - e. A claim with insufficient documentary proof will not be considered for points' calculation.
 - f. Research projects processed through or intimated to Research Dte with proof of funds released to NUST will only be counted.
 - g. Industrial component of funding in research projects will not be considered for Best Researcher Award.
 - h. Publications, projects, research grants, student supervision etc. related to NUST will only be considered.

- i. The best researcher must have some scores in at least 04 categories of the submitted proforma and minimum aggregate score of 25%.

Nomination and Selection Process

5. Nominations will be received on prescribed proforma as per SOP of awards.
6. The summary of scrutineering will be presented to NUST Evaluation Committee (NEC) and the final selection / approval of University Best Researcher Award will be made by NEC. Composition of NEC is:
 - a. Pro-Rector (RIC) Chairman
 - b. Director (Research) Member
 - c. Director (I&C) Member
 - d. Director (PGP) Member
 - e. Director (HR) Member
 - f. AD (M&E) Secy
7. Award will be conferred to the awardee as per SOP (as approved in ACM).

Recommendation
